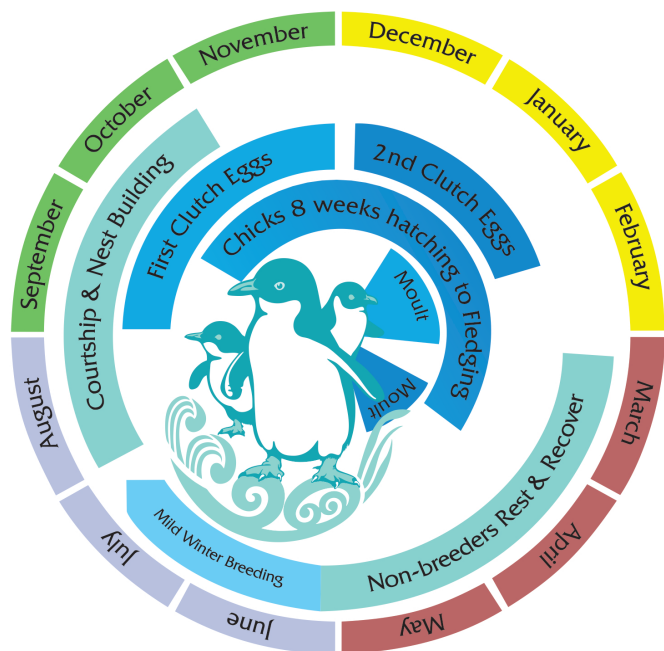

Blue Penguins Pukekura has over 200 nesting pairs with more than 500 birds in the area. Guaranteed viewing, numbers vary from on average 30 in moulting season to an average of 120 in the height of the chick rearing season. The colony is growing 10% per year.

OUR LITTLE BLUE PENGUINS

- World's smallest penguin
- Māori name is kororā
- Ave height 33cm, weight 1kg
- Lifespan about 7 years, oldest in our colony 25
- Able to swim as fast as a bird can fly
- Can dive to 72 metres
- Egg takes 35 days to hatch
