New Zealand Threat Classification System:

Threatened

Nationally Critical - most severely threatened, facing immediate high risk of extinction

Nationally Endangered - facing high risk of extinction in the short term

Nationally Vulnerable - facing high risk of enxtinction in the medium term

Nationally Increasing - small but increasing population still facing risk of extinction in medium term

At Risk

Declining - population declining but still moderately common **Recovering** - population increasing after previously declining **Relict** - small population stabilised after declining **Naturally Uncommon** - naturally small population therefore susceptible to harmful influences
